Alaska Youth Orchestras hosts 2 concerto competitions each calendar season.

1. AYS Concerto Competition – open only to AYS musicians (not piano).
2. AYO Piano Concerto Competition – open to Alaska residents, ages 9-22.

PLEASE NOTE: Applications for the Piano Concerto Competition are accepted only on the **AYO PIANO CONCERTO FORM**.

One AYS Concerto Competition winner will be chosen to perform during AYO's Winter Concert, March 3, 2020. NOTE: Participants should expect to rehearse with AYS several times prior to the concert and should be prepared to do so at any rehearsal during winter quarter.

AYS Concerto Competition Rules

1. Open **ONLY** to current AYS musicians in 11th grade or above during the current season. (Proof of academic status may be requested)
2. Previous AYO Concerto Competition Winners not eligible.
3. Participants are expected to compete on the same instrument they play in AYS unless approval from the AYO Music Director is granted **BEFORE** the application deadline.
4. Participants should prepare the fast (usually first) movement of the concerto – with cadenza, if present. (See the repertoire list for more guidance)
5. Pieces should be about 10 minutes in length. Participants may be allowed (pending approval) to perform two movements **FROM THE SAME WORK** if both movements together total 10 minutes – with approval of the AYO Music Director prior to the application deadline.
6. All pieces **MUST** be pre-approved by the AYO Music Director – see attached list of **SUGGESTED REPERTOIRE**. If the selected piece is not approved, participants may propose an alternate piece within one week of the application deadline.
7. Participants **MUST** perform their piece memorized (without music).
8. Participants may only compete on only one piece for the AYS Concerto Competition.
9. Winners **MAY NOT** perform the same work with another Anchorage/Mat-Su area orchestra during the same season, except with their school ensemble.
10. The winner **MUST** perform the work which they auditioned. No substitutions will be allowed.
11. Participants must provide their own accompanist for the competition only - no pre-recorded accompaniment allowed. (Accompanist's are not judged and may make judicious cuts to orchestral portions of the accompaniment)
12. Spectators are **NOT** allowed in the competition. Only competitors and judges will be allowed in.
13. Participants may compete in both AYO Concerto Competitions (AYS and Piano) if they meet the eligibility rules of both.
14. The same participant **MAY** win both AYO Concerto Competitions.
15. All judge's decisions are final.
