Youth Symphony Auditioning

Auditions have begun for the new Anchorage Youth Symphony, an honor orchestra for advanced instrumentalists of the Anchorage Borough School District.

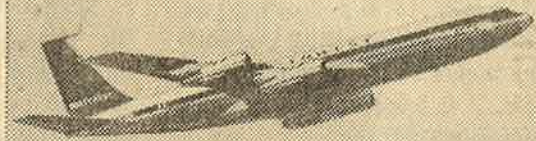
THE YOUTH symphony, which will be conducted by Orchestra Coordinator Frank Pinkerton, is an extension of the junior high all-city orchestra program inaugurated last year.

The new honor orchestra for high school as well as junior high musicians will perform at various times during the year.

String students will be selected by the orchestra teacher at each school. Due to the limited requirement for winds, brass and percussion members, individual auditions will be required for these positions.

THE WIND section will include two flutes, two oboes, two clarinets, two bassoons, two alto saxophones and a tenor saxophone. The brass group will include three trumpets, four French horns, three trombones and a tuba. There also will be two percussion and one timpani position.

The audition schedule at individual schools is as follows: Central, 9 a.m. Tuesday; Wender, 2:45 p.m. Wednesday; Dimond, 3:40 p.m. Wednesday; West, 4 p.m. Wednesday; Romig, 11:35 a.m. Thursday and East at 12:30 p.m. Thursday. Auditions were held at Clark Friday.
