

Festival Head Named

Frank Pinkerton has been named to the post of executive director of the Alaska Festival of Music for 1968. President Ross Wood of the Festival's board of directors made the announcement, saying that Pinkerton will assume his duties immediately.

PINKERTON IS a music coordinator for the Anchorage Borough School District, and was for four years conductor of the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra.

Simultaneously with his appointment, Pinkerton announced that Robert Shaw will return to Anchorage for next June's Festival of Music. "People will be pleased to know that despite his busy first year as conductor of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra, Mr. Shaw definitely will be here for the Festival," the new executive director said.

John Celentano, professor of chamber music at Eastman School of Music in Rochester, N.Y., also will return for next year's music festival. The festival has been set for June 8 through 21, with emphasis on Baroque music.

Mrs. Tom Stewart who resigned as executive director when her husband was appointed a superior court judge. The new director has been chairman of the music committee of the festival board for four years.

He has a bachelor of music degree from the Eastman School of Music and a master's from the University of New Mexico where he was affiliated with the university and was conductor for 10 years of the Los Alamos Symphonietta.

On his arrival in Anchorage. Pinkerton became choral director at East High School and has been instrumental in developing the string program for the school district.
