

# Early Registration Urged For Festival of Music Camp

Teenagers interested in music will have the opportunity to spend two weeks at a music camp this summer. The camp will be held in the established Kings Lake Camp area, approximately 50 miles north of Anchorage, in the Palmer-Big Lake area. It will meet from June 29 to July 12 and is open to all students from grades 7 to 12 who have had some prior musical training. Sixth grade students demonstrating outstanding musical ability and maturity will be considered. The camp has a capacity of 120 students.

Kings Lake Music Camp is being sponsored by the Festival of Music in cooperation with the Anchorage Borough School District and the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra. Its aim is to bring musical instruction and inspiration in a camp experience.

A program tailored to the needs of each student will be developed. Instrumental students will have individualized instruction and a maximum amount of practice time. Choral students will be able to participate in an operetta as well as taking classes.

At the head of the music camp staff will be Frank W. Pinkerton, Director of Music for the Anchorage

Borough School District and Executive Director of the Alaska Festival of Music. Music instructors from the Anchorage area plus performers who will participate in this year's Alaska Festival of Music will comprise the faculty for the Camp. An advisory committee drawn from the music staff of the Anchorage Borough School District will formulate the overall curriculum.

A Music Symposium program will be held and students at the camp may earn one-half a credit toward high school graduation by participating in it. A recommendation from the student's music instructor to the director of the camp is required as a recommendation for this program.

**TUITION FOR THE** two-week session is \$98. This includes housing, meals, private and class lessons, use of the facilities and recreation programs and concerts and recitals.

A registration fee of \$15 must accompany all applications. Further information and applications may be obtained by writing Kings Lake Music Camp, Box 325, Anchorage.

This will be the first of, what is hoped to be, an annual event, sponsored by the Alaska Festival of Music.
