ABOUT THE ORCHESTRA -

The Anchorage Youth Symphony is completing its twelfth season of performing orchestral works of the masters. Formed in 1965 by its present director, Frank Pinkerton, the orchestra presently draws young musicians from the six high schools in the Anchorage School District. A recent modification in membership criteria allows orchestra alumni to age 22 to participate. All members are selected on the basis of competitive auditions.

Activities of the orchestra in addition to its regular concert series include a concerto program featuring young artists, participation in the Anchorage School District High School Music Festival, performances for Anchorage community events and an annual concert tour.

The Anchorage Youth Symphony Association, Inc. was formed to support and extend the activity of the Youth Symphony. The association provides a summer scholarship program for the orchestra in addition to sponsoring the concert tours. Mr. Curtis McVee heads the organization and Joyce McVee has for the past two years served as the tour director.
