On radio he has conducted over 3,000 hours of programs, including America's oldest educational program the Standard School Broadcast, and has received TV's "Emmy" award, as well as an "Oscar" from the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. Mr. Dragon is presently conductor and musical director of the Glendale Symphony Orchestra.



Claudia Cummings, young soprano star from Southern California, has appeared in operatic and oratorio performances throughout the West including appearances in the Los Angeles Music Center and Hollywood Bowl. She made her Carnegie Hall debut earlier this year and her first appearance with the San Francisco Opera this fall. Her wide range of interests in music has also led her to teach elementary school music classes and vocal instruction at the college level.
