Jean-Paul Billaud

Jean-Paul Billaud is a native of France and obtained graduate and undergraduate degrees from the Ecole Normale de Musique de Paris where he earned the "Diplôme Supérieur de Virtuosité" and the "Licence de Concert." He studied under Auguste de Radwan, Marguerite Long, Jacques Fevrier, and Alfred Cortot; also he has worked with composers such as Poulenc, Damase, Milhaud and Marescotti.

Jean-Paul Billaud performed his debut recital in Paris in 1956. He was a prize-winner in several international competitions and has performed throughout Europe. In 1961, he became the official soloist of the French Radio-Television Network, and in 1963, he was selected by the French Ministry of Culture to represent France in the "Biennale de Paris," a fifty-two nation festival. Mr. Billaud came to Alaska in June 1963 and 1964 to represent his native country at the Alaska Festival of Music. He joined the faculty at the University of Alaska in 1965 and was transferred to the Anchorage campus in 1974 where he is now Chairman of the Department of Music.

Bettie Mc Donald

Bettie McDonald is a native of Nashville, Tennessee, and graduated from Nashville College. She pursued graduate studies at Colorado College and the University of Alaska. In 1968, she won the "Woman of the Year" award given by the Colorado Springs Business and Professional Women's Club. In 1967, she was awarded the Valley Forge Teacher's Medal, a Freedom Foundation award. In 1968, she was voted among the Outstanding Women of America.

Bettie McDonald has appeared as soprano soloist with the Anchorage Symphony, the Colorado Springs Symphony, the Houston Symphony and the Lansing, Michigan Symphony. She is Chairman of the Department of Music at Bartlett High School in Anchorage.
