Barry Snyder

PIANIST

When Barry Snyder made his recital debut in Washington D.C., one astonished critic wrote that *"Mr. Snyder plays with the clarity of a Horowitz but with considerably wider and more impulsive contrasts in dynamic level. He will become a spectacular artist indeed."* (Washington Evening Star).

And indeed he has. A year later the Washington Post asserted that *"Snyder has speed and power to burn."* The Rochester Times-Union openly called him *"astonishing."* The Minneapolis Star went on to describe his *"articulation, power, color sense, control and command of an exceptionally wide dynamic range."* The Washington Evening Star came back to print the bold-face headline **"BARRY SNYDER ON WAY TO PIANO GREATNESS."**

One has only to hear Mr. Snyder at the piano to appreciate why so many critics have emptied themselves of raves. His list of top prizes, such as the Van Cliburn International Competition, further confirm his virtuosity. He has played with the Atlanta Symphony, the Rochester Philharmonic, the Detroit Symphony and many other orchestras. His recital appearances have covered the country, including the Alaska Festival of Music in 1968.

A Pennsylvanian by birth, Mr. Snyder began studying piano at the age of eight and made his concert debut at fourteen as soloist with the Allentown Symphony Orchestra under Donald Voorhees. In 1966 he received his Bachelor's Degree from the Eastman School of Music, where he studied under Cecile Staub Genhart. He completed his Master of Music Degree in 1968 with highest honors.
