About the Orchestra . . .

The Anchorage Youth Symphony is completing its thirteenth season of performing orchestral works of the masters. Formed in 1965 by its present director, Frank Pinkerton, the orchestra presently draws young musicians from the six high schools in the Anchorage School District. A recent modification in membership criteria allows orchestra alumni to age 22 to participate. All members are selected on the basis of competitive auditions.

Activities of the orchestra, in addition to its regular concert series, include participation in the High School Music Festival, performances for Anchorage community events, and an annual concert tour which took the orchestra this year to Petersburg, Ketchikan and Terrace B.C.

A three-year resident of Anchorage, Mark Jordan moved here from Petersburg. He is a versatile musician, vocally as well as being proficient on the cello, string bass, piccolo, oboe and recorder. Mark is the son of the Rev. and Mrs. Paul Jordan. His credits include being chosen for the Southeast Alaska Honors Band in '75 and '76, All-State Honors Orchestra '78, listing in Who's Who in Music '78 and is the Valedictorian of the 1978 graduating class of West High School.

A flute student of Sharon Nowak, Lisa Wienhold was selected the outstanding woodwind soloist at the recent district Solo and Ensemble Festival held at the U.A.A. She was selected for the '78 National Honors Band which performed in Chicago, has participated in the Alaska Fine Arts Camp for four years, All-State Band and Orchestra, and next year plans to attend the Interlochen Academy of the Arts in Michigan. She is in the 11th grade at Chugiak High. Her parents are Mr. and Mrs. K. J. Wienhold.

Active in the dramatic arts as well as instrumental music, April Wilson has received superior ratings on both the alto saxophone and clarinet in the district Solo and Ensemble Festivals. A student in the 11th grade at East High, she is in the Stage and Symphonic bands there. She has been accepted into both the Universal Academy of Music's European Tour and the American Youth Symphony and Chorus concert tour. April has attended the AFAC at King's Lake four summers, three as a scholarship winner.

A 9th grader at Dimond High, a trumpet student for 4-1/2 years, and a bass guitar instrumentalist -- this is John Harris. The Haydn Concerto is his most ambitious undertaking this far. John has participated in the fine arts program at King's Lake and Solo and Ensemble Festivals. The son of Mr. and Mrs. R. Everett Harris, he is an earnest and enthusiastic sportsman. It would be fun to crystal gaze into the musical future of this promising young musician.

Nine years have passed since Helen Howarth first picked up a cello bow to study seriously, and since that time until the present she has participated in many musical activities. The Basically Bach Orchestra, King's Lake Fine Arts Camp, the All-Northwest Orchestra '77, All-State Orchestra for two years, and a Youth Symphony member five years -- this names a few. Helen's parents are Mr. and Mrs. Phil Howarth and she attends East High where she is a graduating senior. Helen has the distinction of being selected as the outstanding string soloist for two years at the High School Solo and Ensemble Festival.

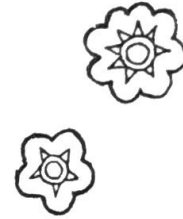
