About the Orchestra . . .

The Anchorage Youth Symphony is completing its fifteenth season of performing orchestral works of the masters. Formed in 1965 by Frank Pinkerton, former Coordinator of Instrumental Music with the Anchorage School District, the orchestra presently draws musicians from the six high schools in the Anchorage area. The orchestra this year includes students who are in the 9-12 grade range, all of whom were selected on the basis of competitive auditions.

The orchestra's conductor, Dewey Ehling, is in his second year as conductor of the orchestra and also in his second year as Director of Music for the Anchorage School District, having responsibility for the entire music program K-12.

Activities of the orchestra in addition to its regular concert series, include a concerto program featuring young artists, participation in the Region IV High School Music Festival, performances for Anchorage community events, and an annual concert tour.

The Anchorage Youth Symphony Association, Inc., was formed to support and extend the activity of the Youth Symphony. The association provides a summer scholarship program for the orchestra in addition to sponsoring the concert tours. Dorothy Erickson heads the organization and Nancye Brodie serves as tour director.
