About the Orchestra...

The Anchorage Youth Symphony is completing its nineteenth season of performing orchestra works of the masters. Formed in 1965, the orchestra draws musicians from the six public high schools in the Anchorage area, and also from private schools and neighboring communities. The orchestra includes students who are in the 9-12 grade range, all of whom were selected on the basis of competitive auditions.

The orchestra's conductor, Dewey Ehling, is in his sixth year as conductor of the orchestra and also in his sixth year as Director of Music for the Anchorage School District, having responsibility for the entire music program K-12.

Activities of the orchestra in addition to its regular concert series, include a concerto program featuring young artists, performances for Anchorage community events, and an annual concert tour.

The Anchorage Youth Symphony Association, Inc., was formed to support and extend the activities of the Youth Symphony. The association provides a summer scholarship program for the orchestra in addition to sponsoring the concert tours. Next year, the orchestra's twentieth anniversary, students will appear in the Melbourne, Australia Festival, August 8-18, 1985.
