LA SORELLA

Borel-Clerc

La Sorella is a characteristic concert march on Spanish themes.

SYMPHONY NO. 25 in G Minor

W. A Mozart

Symphony No. 25 is not only one of Mozart's finest works in this form, but is also within the technical reach of Junior High players. Although this version is edited for school use, the trio section of the Menuetto has been rescored to the original to feature the oboe section.

SYMPHONY NO. 2

P. I. Tschaikovsky

Tschaikovsky has produced a miniature gem. This little march packs enormous vitality in a short time frame.

OVERTURE 'Egmont'

Ludwig van Beethoven

In 1809 Beethoven composed incidental music for Goethe's play about the Flemish nobleman, Count Egmont. Egmont was a valiant soldier and fiery politician who dedicated his efforts to the liberation of the Netherlands until he was finally captured and executed. The overture portrays a wide range of emotions from tragic to triumphant.

PASSACAGLIA AND FUGUE in C Minor

Johann Sebastian Bach

The passacaglia is a continuous set of melodic variations over a repeating bass line; the fugue is an intricate working of this bass line through the entire musical texture.

Bach originally wrote this great work for organ and the conductor, Leopold Stokowski, arranged the piece for large orchestra.

THREE DANCES FROM THE BARTERED BRIDE

Bedrich Smetana

1. POLKA 2. FURIANT 3. DANCE OF THE COMEDIANS (SKOCNA)

The 'Bartered Bride', Smetana's most popular opera, was completed in 1866. It was written for the new Czech National Theater where Smetana later became principal conductor. The three dances played here add much to the spectacle of this light-hearted opera.
