SENIOR SPOTLIGHT - Katie Pidgeon

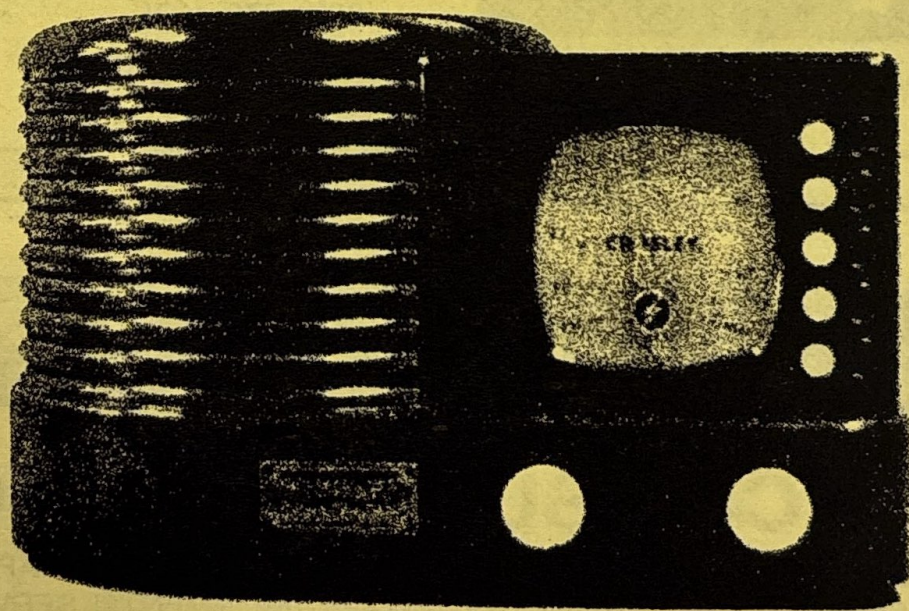
Katie Pidgeon

Last year she was one of two bass players from Alaska to go to Portland for All Northwest orchestra. She is on the Honor Roll, in the National Honor Society, and was an Honor Marshall last spring in East High's graduation activities. Outside of music she writes a lot, is interested in human

health and also is a runner. In the meantime, she studies and teaches privately, and helps her orchestra teacher teach string bass to students in the orchestra at Russian Jack school.
